

Program Roll-Out Guidelines:

ALASKA



The print version of ServSafe Alcohol™ is approved for use in Alaska.

Alcohol licensees and their employees must take an approved alcohol server training course within 30 days of employment or licensing. A server who was certified in another state must still take an approved alcohol server training course within 30 days of employment in Alaska. Certification must be renewed every 3 years.

There is a supplement for Alaska that must be incorporated into the ServSafe Alcohol training course given in the state. Approved ServSafe Alcohol instructors can download the Alaska supplement at www.nraef.org/irc.

A training course must cover 16 specific areas of Alaskan law to be approved by the Board. The ServSafe Alcohol training course and exam provided by the Alaska Hospitality Alliance (AHA) meets this requirement.
