

Program Roll-Out Guidelines: MINNESOTA



In Minnesota, responsible alcohol service training is voluntary. ServSafe Alcohol™ is an approved program in Minnesota.

There are jurisdictions that may have their own guidelines or requirements. It is best to directly contact the county or municipal liquor authority where you operate an establishment.
