

Program Roll-Out Guidelines:

NEBRASKA



In Nebraska, responsible alcohol service training is voluntary. ServSafe Alcohol™ is an approved program in Nebraska. There is a supplement for Nebraska that must be incorporated into the ServSafe Alcohol training course given in the state. Approved ServSafe Alcohol instructors can download the Nebraska supplement at www.nraef.org/irc.

If a sale to minor violation occurs, proof that the server has completed a training program may be used to qualify for a mitigating benefit.

The Nebraska Liquor Control Commission recommends that licensees maintain records on all employees who have received training. Instructors of approved programs are required to submit a complete student sign-in sheet to the LCC upon completion of the class.
