MINORS ALLOWED ON PREMISE?	In establishments where sales from food account for more than 50% of total sales, minors are allowed in the establishment but not in the designated bar area. Minors are not permitted in establishments whose food sales are less than 50%. Minors are not permitted in retail stores for any reason at any time, except in a package liquor store when accompanied by a parent or guardian, and if not prohibited by local ordinance.
CAN PARENTS SERVE?	It is unlawful to serve or sell alcohol to anyone under the age of 21. Minors are not allowed to consume alcohol in the presence of their parents or legal guardians under any circumstances, either on or off a licensed premise.
HOURS OF SERVICE	On Premise Establishments: Hours set by county ordinance. Sunday sales, holidays and elections days: 10:00 a.m. until 2:00 a.m. Off Premise / Retail Stores: Monday thru Saturday, 10:00 a.m. until 9:00 p.m. Closed Sunday. Statutory closing on election days until 7:00 p.m. as well as specific holidays. Off-premises licensees may not sell on certain election days (general, primary, run-off primary, special election, state, county or city elections, and franchise elections. Stores may remain open during school board elections.)

LEGAL LEVEL OF INTOXICATION WHILE DRIVING	.08 BAC
DRAM SHOP LAW	No legislation. Some case law.
ID CONFISCATION	Licensees may hold identification until authorities are notified and ID is turned in.
HAPPY HOUR & OTHER SERVICE RESTRICTIONS	The law does differentiate between "happy hour", "drink specials", and "promotions". Happy Hours are illegal - no reduced drink prices. Drink specials must occur for an entire calendar week (e.g. Sunday-Saturday). Promotions are allowed if they follow the same calendar week schedule. The law does not allow a licensee to offer a food and drink combination for a special price.
PENALTIES FOR SERVING OR SELLING TO A MINOR	For low-point beer: Misdemeanor punishable by up to 1 year imprisonment and/or up to \$550 fine. All other alcoholic beverages: Felony punishable by \$2,500 to \$5,000 fine and/or up to 5 years imprisonment.
