Program Roll-Out Guidelines:



New Hampshire

New Hampshire does not regulate training at the server level. However, <u>licensees and</u> <u>designated managers must take a mandatory Management Training Seminar</u> (MTS) provided by the New Hampshire State Liquor Commission.

<u>Training staff and managers</u> in responsible alcohol service principles, including state and local laws, may be considered a mitigating factor by the commission in the event of a violation. The <u>ServSafe Alcohol[™] program meets these qualifications</u> in New Hampshire.

No forms or documentation need to be submitted to the Commission when employees are certified through the ServSafe Alcohol program. It is recommended that licensees keep a record of all trained employees for possible mitigation benefits in the future.
