

Program Roll-Out Guidelines:

Utah



Responsible alcohol service training is mandatory in Utah. The ServSafe Alcohol™ program is approved for use in Utah.

All alcohol servers, managers and supervisors must successfully complete and pass an approved alcohol server training course and exam within 30 days from their date of hire. Certification must be renewed every 3 years by completing and passing an approved training course and exam.

If a server was certified in another state through a Division approved alcohol server training course, the server can pass the portion of the exam that applies to Utah's alcohol laws within 30 days of employment to be certified in Utah. Instructors must incorporate the Utah supplement into their training classes. Approved ServSafe Alcohol Instructors can download the Utah supplement at www.servsafe.org/.

The instructor shall submit to the Division the name, Social Security number, certificate expiration date, test results indicating pass or fail and a fee of \$2.50, for each student within 30 days of the completion of the course.
