

Program Roll-Out Guidelines: WISCONSIN

In Wisconsin, responsible alcohol service training is <u>mandatory</u>. Applicants for an operator's license must have completed a responsible alcohol service training program. ServSafe Alcohol® is an approved program in Wisconsin. There are some exceptions which can be found at <u>www.dor.state.wi.us</u>.

In order to teach the ServSafe Alcohol course in the State of Wisconsin, you must:

- Be an approved ServSafe Alcohol Instructor
- Obtain the Wisconsin Supplement from your ServSafe Alcohol instructor or via the content within the WI SSA Online Course.
- Teach the ServSafe Alcohol curriculum along with the Wisconsin Supplement
- Give the ServSafe Alcohol Exam and the Wisconsin Exam. Return answer sheets to the National Restaurant Association for grading.
