

ServSafe Alcohol Program Roll-Out Guidelines:



Alaska

ServSafe Alcohol is currently not approved in Alaska.

Alcohol licensees and their employees must take an approved alcohol server training course within 30 days of employment or licensing. A server who was certified in another state must still take an approved alcohol server training course within 30 days of employment in Alaska. Certification must be renewed every 3 years.

A training course must cover 16 specific areas of Alaskan law to be approved by the Board. The exam provided by the Alaska Hospitality Alliance (AHA) meets this requirement. The AHA can be contacted at (907) 272-6201 or through their website at <http://www.akhla.org/>.
