

ServSafe Alcohol Program Roll-Out Guidelines:

California

Responsible Beverage Service training in California is **mandatory** for all on-premises alcohol servers and their managers within 60 days from date of hire. The ServSafe Alcohol™ Program is an approved RBS training provider in the state.

<u>Step-By-Step California Alcohol Examinee Instructions</u> on how to register with the California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control, complete the ServSafe Alcohol California RBS training course and take the CABC online exam.

Exemption to license of servicing/selling alcohol AB-2378

A license or permit isn't required if no additional fee or charge of alcoholic beverages during services:

- Serving alcoholic beverages as part of service provided by a limousine service regulated by the Public Utilities Commission.
- Serving alcoholic beverages as part of service provided by a hot air balloon ride
- Serving beer or wine as part of service provided by the State Board of Barbering and Cosmetology
