

## ServSafe Alcohol Program Roll-Out Guidelines:



### Connecticut

In Connecticut, responsible alcohol service server training is voluntary. ServSafe Alcohol™ is an approved program in Connecticut.

Effective January 1, 2026, the Connecticut Department of Consumer Protection requires all on-premises and off-premises permit applicants to complete the Connecticut Liquor Law Education Program: [https://portal.ct.gov/dcp/liquor-control/liquor-law-education-program?language=en\\_US](https://portal.ct.gov/dcp/liquor-control/liquor-law-education-program?language=en_US) . This includes: The applicant, the permittee, the backer entity, And all individual owners /members /shareholders of the backer entity, and full ownership structure.
