

ServSafe Alcohol Program Roll-Out Guidelines:



Georgia

Georgia is a voluntary state for responsible alcohol service training or training program providers. The state does not require licensees to keep employee training documentation nor are there any mandatory forms that need to be submitted by the employee or licensee. ServSafe™ Alcohol is an approved program in Georgia.

The Georgia Alcohol & Tobacco Division warned that there are jurisdictions that may have their own guidelines or requirements. It is best to directly contact the county or municipal liquor authority where you operate an establishment. County contact information is available through <https://georgia.gov/>.
