

## ServSafe Alcohol Program Roll-Out Guidelines:



### Iowa

In Iowa responsible alcohol service training is voluntary but required for servers and bartenders. ServSafe Alcohol™ is an approved program in Iowa.

\*\*The Iowa Alcoholic Beverages Commission of the Iowa Department of Revenue regulates the sale and service of alcoholic beverages in restaurants and food establishments. In order to sell or serve alcoholic beverages they must obtain a liquor license. The ABD requires anyone selling or serving alcohol (bartenders and servers) to have responsible alcohol service training (RAST) of at least 2 hours of alcohol related training, which includes Iowa's laws and regulations.
