Kansas

In Kansas, responsible alcohol service training is voluntary with mitigation benefits. ServSafe Alcohol™ is an approved program in Kansas.

There are possible mitigation benefits given for training of licensees and their employees. Please contact the Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control (DABC) for more information.

A licensee must maintain on the licensed premises a roster of all employees who are involved in the sale or service of alcoholic liquor.
