Kansas

In Kansas, responsible alcohol service training is <u>voluntary with mitigation benefits</u>. ServSafe Alcohol[™] is an approved program in Kansas.

There are <u>possible mitigation benefits</u> given for training of licensees and their employees. Please contact the Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control (DABC) for more information.

A licensee must maintain on the licensed premises a roster of all employees who are involved in the sale or service of alcoholic liquor.
