

ServSafe Alcohol Program Roll-Out Guidelines:



Kentucky

In Kentucky, responsible alcohol service training is county/city required. County/City program preapproval is needed before a program is accepted in required counties. However, in voluntary counties, ServSafe can be used.

The ABC may require completion of responsible alcohol service training instead of or in addition to suspension of a license when a violation occurs.

Checking with local jurisdiction for accepted verification is highly recommended.
