THE SERVSAFE ALCOHOL ONLINE PROGRAM IS <u>APPROVED</u> FOR USE IN NEW MEXICO.

In New Mexico, responsible alcohol service training is mandatory.

The instructors of the approved programs provide course materials to students at the beginning of each class. Instructor certificates are issued by the division and expire each year on December 31st.
