ServSafe Alcohol Program Roll-Out Guidelines:



Rhode Island

In Rhode Island, <u>all employees</u>, including supervisory employees, who sell or serve alcohol or check I.D.'s and valet parking staff <u>must</u> complete alcohol server training. Employees must complete training within 60 days from their date of hire. Servers must be recertified every 3 years by completing an approved training program.

There is a supplement for Rhode Island that must be incorporated into the ServSafe Alcohol training course given in the state. Approved ServSafe Alcohol instructors can download the Rhode Island supplement at ServSafe Supplements.
