## ServSafe Alcohol Program Roll-Out Guidelines:



## South Dakota

In South Dakota, responsible alcohol service training is <u>voluntary with mitigating benefits</u>. ServSafe Alcohol<sup>m</sup> is an approved program in South Dakota.

**Mitigating benefit**: The fines for first and second violations are cut in half for the licensee if the employee who sells or serves alcohol to a minor has completed an approved alcohol training program.

There is a supplement for South Dakota that must be incorporated into the ServSafe Alcohol training course given in the state. Approved ServSafe Alcohol instructors can download the South Dakota supplement at  $\underline{\mathsf{ServSafe Supplements}}$ .
