

ServSafe Alcohol Program Roll-Out Guidelines:

Utah

Responsible alcohol service training is <u>mandatory</u> in Utah. The ServSafe Alcohol™ program is approved for use in Utah.

<u>All</u> alcohol servers, managers and supervisors <u>must</u> successfully complete and pass an approved alcohol server training course and exam before beginning employment. Certification must be renewed every 3 years by completing and passing an approved training course and exam.

If a server was certified in another state through a Division approved alcohol server training course, the server can pass the portion of the exam that applies to Utah's alcohol laws before beginning employment in order to be certified in Utah.
