St. Landry Parish

Hours of Operation

It shall be unlawful for anyone to sell or to serve alcoholic beverages or beer in any business establishment within St. Landry Parish, Louisiana, between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. daily.

Sunday Sales

In the Parish of St. Landry, there are no laws prohibiting the sale of alcohol on Sundays.

Noise Regulations

The Parish of St. Landry does have laws governing noise created by businesses. Generally speaking, you should not create a level of noise that disturbs your neighbors. For specific requirements of the noise ordinance, you should consult an attorney.

Litter

You should always maintain the premises by conducting daily litter pick-ups.

Happy Hour Regulations

It is prohibited to sell or serve any alcoholic beverages at a price fixed on an "all you can drink" basis after the hour of 10:00 p.m.

Zoning

Zoning laws restrict what sort of activity can or can't occur in your establishment. For instance, no permit authorizing the sale of any alcoholic beverage under this chapter shall be granted for any premises situated within 300 feet or less of a parish or municipal playground or of a building used exclusively as a regular church or synagogue, public library, school, full-time day care center, or a correctional facility housing inmates, including but not limited to a halfway house.

There are exceptions to this law such as a hotel or fraternal organization. Please review with your manager or owner what is and is not allowed at your particular location.

Leaving premises with alcohol

In the Parish of St. Landry, it is legal for customers to leave the premises with open containers of alcohol.

Local Licensing of Servers and Local Server Training

The state law that requires servers to attend this course also says that servers do not have to attend local server training courses if they participate in a state-approved course.

Other Regulations

Special permits are required for outdoor (parking lot etc.) activity.

City of Eunice

Hours of Operation

In the City of Eunice, alcohol may not be sold between the hours of 2 a.m. and 5 a.m. everyday. During the prohibited hours, it is only the owner or manager or their employees may remain on premise and consumption of alcoholic beverages is not allowed.

Sunday Sales

In the City of Eunice, there are no laws prohibiting the sale of alcohol on Sundays.

Noise Regulations

The City of Eunice does have laws governing noise created by businesses. Generally speaking, you should not create a level of noise that disturbs your neighbors. For specific requirements of the noise ordinance, you should consult an attorney.

Litter

You should always maintain the premises by conducting daily litter pick-ups.

Zoning

Zoning laws restrict what sort of activity can or can't occur in your establishment. Please review with your manager or owner what is and is not allowed at your particular location.

Leaving premises with alcohol

In the City of Eunice, it is illegal to consume alcoholic beverages on the streets or sidewalks of the city except during Mardi Gras, the Louisiana Folklife Festival and other authorized special events.

Local Licensing of Servers and Local Server Training

In the City of Eunice, anyone who works, directly or indirectly selling and serving alcohol in a saloon or in the selling and serving of beer in a beer parlor must obtain a certificate of qualification from the chief of police. Anyone who applies for such a certificate must be a resident of the City of Eunice for at least 30 days prior to filing the application for the certificate.

The City of Eunice does require not require any form of local server training.

The new state law that requires servers to attend this course also says that servers do not have to attend local server training courses if they participate in a state-approved course. By 2000, you will have to participate in state-approved courses.

Other Regulations

In the City of Eunice any business wishing to sell beer must submit, with their permit application, a written statement signed by at least 50% of resident property owners residing within 300 feet of the proposed business location, stating that they have no objection to the issuance of a beer permit to the applicant for that location.

In the City of Eunice, it is illegal for licensed establishments to allow nude, semi-nude or topless dancing.

Town of Grand Coteau

Hours of Operation

In the Town of Grand Coteau, it is illegal to sell or serve alcohol or to remain open for business if you are a business licensed to sell alcohol, between the hours of 2 a.m. and 6 a.m. everyday.

Sunday Sales

In the Town of Grand Coteau, there are no laws prohibiting sale of alcohol on Sunday.

Noise Regulations

The Town of Grand Coteau does have laws governing noise created by businesses. Generally speaking, you should not create a level of noise that disturbs your neighbors. For specific requirements of the noise ordinance, you should consult an attorney.

Litter

You should always maintain the premises by conducting daily litter pick-ups.

Zoning

Zoning laws restrict what sort of activity can or can't occur in your establishment. Please review with your manager or owner what is and is not allowed at your particular location.

Leaving premises with alcohol

In the Town of Grand Coteau, there are no laws prohibiting the possession of an open container of alcohol.

Local Licensing of Servers and Local Server Training

The Town of Grand Coteau does not require any form of alcohol server permit, "Bar Card" or ABO Card.

The Town of Grand Coteau does not require any form of local server training.

The new state law that requires servers to attend this course also says that servers do not have to attend local server training courses if they participate in a state-approved course. By 2000, you will have to participate in state-approved courses.

Town of Leonville

Hours of Operation

In the Town of Leonville, there are no hours of operation and sale in the town code of ordinances.

Sunday Sales

In the Town of Leonville, there are no laws prohibiting sale of alcohol on Sunday.

Noise Regulations

The Town of Leonville does have laws governing noise created by businesses. Generally speaking, you should not create a level of noise that disturbs your neighbors. For specific requirements of the noise ordinance, you should consult an attorney.

Litter

You should always maintain the premises by conducting daily litter pick-ups.

Zoning

Zoning laws restrict what sort of activity can or can't occur in your establishment. Please review with your manager or owner what is and is not allowed at your particular location.

Leaving premises with alcohol

In the Town of Leonville, it is illegal to consume alcoholic beverages or to possess an open container of alcohol in or on any public property or in a vehicle that is not in motion and is on public property or private property subject to public use. It is also illegal to remove an open container of alcohol from any business licensed to sell alcoholic beverages. The town council of Leonville may waive the provisions of the open container law, except for glass containers, for a festival or celebration licensed by the town.

City of Opelousas

Hours of Operation

In the City of Opelousas, alcohol may not be sold between the hours of 2 a.m. and 6 a.m. everyday. During the prohibited hours, licensed establishments must be closed. However, the business may stay open for the sale of other, non-alcohol related items so long as customers are prevented from entering the physical part of the business where alcohol is sold. These areas of a business must be cordoned off by physical restraints such as curtains, chains or ropes. Consumption of alcohol is prohibited in licensed establishments between the hours of 2:30 a.m. and 6 a.m.

Sunday Sales

In the City of Opelousas, there are no laws prohibiting the sale of alcohol on Sundays.

In the City of Opelousas, does not require servers or managers to get local server or "Bar Cards".

The City of Opelousas does require not require any form of local server training.

The new state law that requires servers to attend this course also says that servers do not have to attend local server training courses if they participate in a state-approved course. By 2000, you will have to participate in state-approved courses.

Other Regulations

In the City of Opelousas, licensed establishment may not sell alcohol unless the business is located on the ground or street level of the building it occupies. Licensed establishments must also have an unobstructed view of the inside with a full view through any door or window of all the rooms in which alcohol is sold. Licensed establishments must be well lighted after dark.

In the City of Opelousas, it is illegal to sell alcohol in a dwelling, boarding, lodging or rooming house.

In the City of Opelousas, it is illegal for licensed establishments to have vulgar or obscene pictures or books.

In the City of Opelousas, it is illegal for licensed establishments to allow nude, semi-nude or topless dancing.

In the City of Opelousas, it is illegal for a licensed establishment to provide chairs or benches outside of the business

Village of Palmetto

The Village of Palmetto is dry.

Town of Sunset

Hours of Operation

In the Town of Sunset, alcohol may not be sold or served between the hours of 2 a.m. and 6 a.m. every day. During prohibited hours, no one is allowed to enter or remain or consume alcohol on the premise of the licensed establishment except for the proprietor and employees of the business.

Sunday Sales

In the Town of Sunset, there are no laws prohibiting the sale of alcohol on Sundays.

Noise Regulations

The Town of Sunset does have laws governing noise created by businesses. Generally speaking, you should not create a level of noise that disturbs your neighbors. For specific requirements of the noise ordinance, you should consult an attorney.
