Program Roll-Out Guidelines:



Washington D.C.

In the District of Columbia, responsible alcohol service training is $\underline{\text{mandatory}}$ for managers. The ServSafe AlcoholTM Classroom and Online Program is currently approved for use in the District of Columbia.

Managers must have a manager's license to manage a licensed establishment. The manager's license is valid for 2 years. The fee covers both years that the license is valid and is paid at the time that the manager applies for the license. The application is available at

Managers must complete an approved alcohol server training course prior to applying for a manager's license. Proof of certification must be submitted to ABRA on a form provided by the approved course provider. Managers must renew their certification every 2 years.
