

ServSafe Alcohol Program Roll-Out Guidelines:

Michigan

Supervisory employees who are present on the premises during hours that alcohol is sold or served <u>must</u> be trained in an approved alcohol server training course. The ServSafe Alcohol® program is approved for use in Michigan and is offered through the Michigan Restaurant & Lodging Association (MRLA). Instructors of approved alcohol server training programs must be certified by the Michigan Liquor Control Commission (MLCC). To teach ServSafe Alcohol in the state of Michigan, you <u>must</u> contact the MRLA to become an approved instructor on their roster. The MRLA will provide all the necessary documents for you to begin your training and ensure that your classes are in compliance with Michigan's requirements.
