ID CONFISCATION	Yes, due to it being illegal for any minor to use a fake id or the identification of another person in an attempt to purchase liquor or to obtain employment to serve or sell liquor in a licensed establishment.
HAPPY HOUR & OTHER SERVICE RESTRICTIONS	There are no prohibitions against happy hour, where special drink prices are featured. Promotions that encourage the excessive consumption of alcohol, such as "all you can drink" for a fixed price are prohibited.
