North Dakota

In North Dakota, responsible alcohol service training is <u>voluntary with mitigating benefits</u>. ServSafe Alcohol™ is an approved program in North Dakota.

<u>Mitigating benefits</u>: If licensee's employees have taken an approved alcohol server training course that addressed intoxication, drunk driving, and underage drinking. Having this taken will lessen the punishment/penalty to the retail licensee.
